Sci-Fic Fantasy Mandel STATION ELEVEN

Some survivors and victims of a pandemic strive to preserve art, culture and kindness.

Sci-Fic Fantasy Howey WOOL (*Silo series*)

In a post-apocalyptic world, people live in a giant underground silo. Inside, people live in a society full of regulations, and Sheriff Holston unexpectedly breaks the greatest taboo of all: He asks to go outside.

Sci-Fic Fantasy Jemisin THE FIFTH SEASON (*Broken Earth trilogy*)

When her husband murders their son and abducts their daughter, grief-stricken and vengeful Essun pursues him across The Stillness, a vast and dynamic super-continent on the brink of catastrophe that will usher in a "fifth season," a time of uncertainty and hardship.

Sci-Fic Fantasy Aaronovitch MIDNIGHT RIOT (*River of London series*)

With his ability to speak with the lingering dead, PC Peter Grant is drawn into a world where ancient evil is making a comeback on a rising tide of murder and dark magic.

Sci-Fic Fantasy Walker THE AGE OF MIRACLES

A coming-of-age story about young Julia, who discovers that the Earth's rotation has suddenly slowed, posing a catastrophic threat to all life.

Sci-Fic Fantasy Cronin THE PASSAGE (*Passage trilogy*)

The latest test subject in a covert government experiment, abandoned six-year-old Amy is rescued by an FBI agent who hides them in the

Oregon hills, from which Amy emerges a century later to save the human race from a terrifying virus.

Sci-Fic Fantasy Brown RED RISING (*Red Rising trilogy*)

A tale set in a bleak future society torn by class divisions follows the experiences of secret revolutionary Darrow, who after witnessing his wife's execution by an oppressive government joins a revolutionary cell and attempts to infiltrate an elite military academy.

Sci-Fic Fantasy VanderMeer ANNIHILATION (*Southern Reach series*)

Area X has claimed the lives of members of eleven expeditions. The twelfth expedition consisting of four women hopes to map the terrain, collect specimens; to record all their observations; and, above all, to avoid being contaminated by Area X itself.

First in the epic saga of the Gunslinger and his pursuit of the Man in Black.

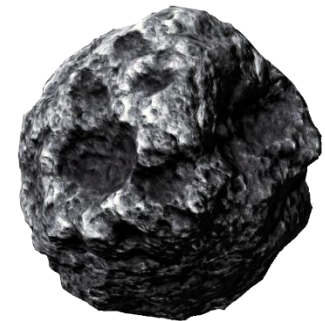

Submit Book Reviews

- Write a short review of a book, audiobook or article you have read from Sep 1st – Nov 30th.
- Return completed reviews to the Information Desk before December 1st.
Note: you may also submit your reviews online.
- You will receive 1 entry into the season's end drawing for every review submitted.

Play Bingo

- Read or listen to books from Sep 1st – Nov 30th which fit the descriptions in a bingo row (vertical, horizontal, diagonal). More sheets are available upon request.
- Return the completed bingo sheet to the Information Desk before December 1st.
