Fiction Hosseini **THE KITE RUNNER**

Afghanistan – An unlikely friendship forms between a well-to-do boy and the son of his father's servant in the years leading up to the Soviet-Afghan War.

Fiction Esquivel **LIKE WATER FOR CHOCOLATE**

Mexico - A young woman longs to marry her lover, but family tradition forbids it, so she cooks to express her feelings.

Fiction Ruiz Zafon **THE SHADOW OF THE WIND**

Spain - The son of an antiquarian book dealer finds a mysterious volume by a man named Julián Carax and soon discovers that all remaining copies of the book are being systematically destroyed.

Mystery Nguyen **THE SYMPATHIZER**

Vietnam - A Viet Cong agent spies on a South Vietnamese army general and his compatriots as they start a new life in 1975 Los Angeles.

SciFi-Fantasy Liu **THE THREE-BODY PROBLEM**

China – A secret military project's signal is received by an alien civilization on the brink of destruction during China's Cultural Revolution.

Fiction Adichie **AMERICANAH**

Nigeria - A young woman from Nigeria leaves behind her home and her first love to start a new life in America, only to find her dreams are not all as she expected.

Fiction Lee **PACHINKO**

Korea - In early 1900s Korea, prized daughter Sunja finds herself pregnant and alone, bringing shame on her family until a young tubercular minister offers to marry her and move with her to Japan.

Mystery Nesbo **THE SNOWMAN**

Norway - Detective Harry Hole investigates the disappearance of a woman whose scarf is found on a mysteriously built snowman.

Mystery Penny **STILL LIFE**

Canada - Chief Inspector Armand Gamache of the Surêté du Québec is called to the scene of a suspicious death in a rural village south of Montreal.

Mystery Horowitz **THE WORD IS MURDER**

England - Horowitz, the author, plays the part of narrator and gets caught up in solving a murder with Daniel Hawthorne, a curmudgeonly, out-of-work detective.


