Effective on Friday, March 13, 2020, at 6:00 PM, the Logan Library will close for at least two weeks. Our tentative reopening date is Monday March 30 at 10:00 am. We will keep you updated if that date changes. This decision was made in partnership with Logan Mayor Holly Daines. The Logan Library Board members are also in support of this closure.

Due dates of all items will be extended through March 30, 2020. The book drops will be open so you may return your items. Holds will also be held here at the library for you until we reopen.

Our Pick-It-Up Service will continue to be available for any patron wanting to pick up holds. Staff will be available from 10-5 to take your items to your car. Please have your library card available to show the staff member. Call us at 435-716-9121 when you are parked on the south side of the library in front of the signs on the gate to the dumpster.
