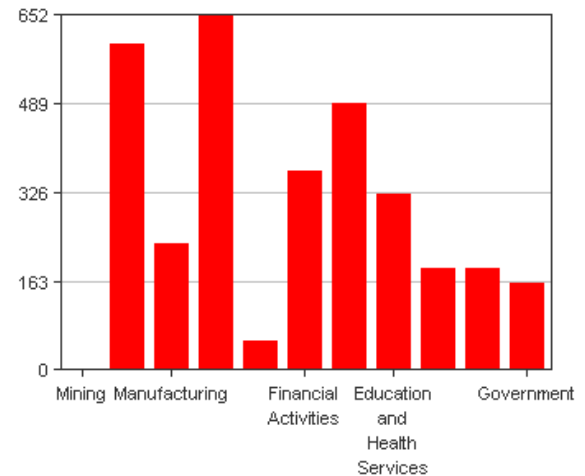

- **Statistical Abstract of the United States** - U.S. Census Bureau publication with data for the entire United States covering topics such as population, agriculture, business, housing, education, government, geography, health, income and transportation.
- **U.S. Department of Labor Bureau of Labor Statistics** - Nationwide and local statistics on labor and business in the United States.
- **Utah Economic and Business Review** - Bimonthly publication reporting on trends and developments relating to the Utah economy.
- **Utah Economic Data Viewer** - Department of Workforce Services Site with information on occupations, economic profiles of Utah counties, wages, Utah labor force and Utah industries.
