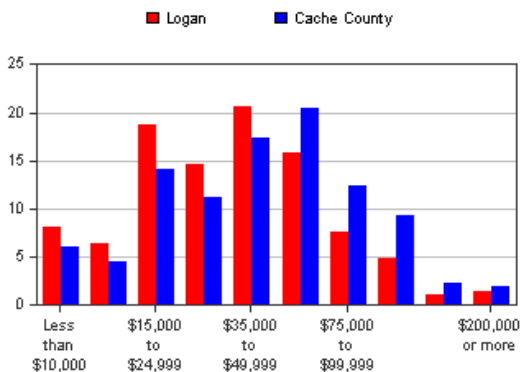

- **Annual Report of Labor Market Information: 2012** - Statewide and county level data on businesses, employment, wages and the labor force in Utah. Provided by the Utah Department of Workforce Services.
- **Cache County Auditor** - The Auditors office provides core financial services for the county government by tracking budget expenditures, revenues, fixed assets, grants, payroll processes, issuing receipts and reporting the same for all departments and funds of the county.
