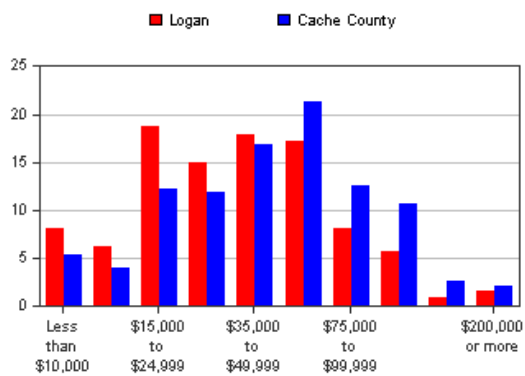

- **American FactFinder** - U.S. Census Bureau site with census data for U.S. states, counties, cities and zip codes. Includes data on population, income and employment, education levels, housing and business.
- **Annual Report of Labor Market Information** - Statewide and county level data on businesses, employment, wages and the labor force in Utah. Provided by the Utah Department of Workforce Services.
- **Cache County Auditor** - The Auditors office provides core financial services for the county government by tracking budget expenditures, revenues, fixed assets, grants, payroll processes, issuing receipts and reporting the same for all departments and funds of the county.
- **City-Data** - Detailed, informative profiles of all cities in the United States from crime rates to weather patterns.
- **County Business Patterns** - Annual reports on business trends and industries for each state in the U.S. Provided by the United States Census Bureau.

- **Utah Economic Data Viewer** - Department of Workforce Services Site with information on occupations, economic profiles of Utah counties, wages, Utah labor force and Utah industries.
- **Utah Economic Report to the Governor** - Serves as the preeminent source for data, research, and analysis related to the Utah economy.
