#### **Action Items:**

Book Sale Report (including discussion of Gift Cards) Nelda-thank you for the flyers! Library staff said they flew out fast and were placed around the community and campus. Questions were asked about "FLL" so it gave them an opportunity to ask what that was. Patrons were very impressed by the book sale. Unloaded about 60% of the stock that they had, which had never happened before. Gift cards did not happen this book sale. Advertise it for the next one. Next sale will be: September 13-16 (minus Sunday). Set up Friday morning, Members only on Friday. General on Saturday and Monday. Monday evening clean up. Set up and reorganize the bookstore to help bring new stock forward. July board meeting will have more of a discussion. Yellow stickers, one more chance. Yellow sticker with dot (black marker). Great volunteer group to help set up and take down. Brad did a great job organizing.

JaDene: Suggested to advertise for children's picture books about a month before the book sale. Advertise on FB and Insta. All August advertise for them. Children's goes fast! Ask for them to bring Elementary reading level books.

Bylaws Revisions: In the past the vice president/president elect, general members and ..... Would get together and revise the bylaws. It was a laborious process. Brad proposes that we take a small section and revise it month to month instead of all at once. All board members look over it, suggest changes. Vote as a board at the annual meeting. Those would be sent out over email and review it in meeting to be on the record. Start as soon as possible. Joseph suggested to go from changing the bylaws every year to every three years.
