**BUSINESS:**

- The meeting was chaired by Vicki Blanch
- Ronald reported on the status of the 2003-04 budget.
- Ronald reported that the library has received an LSTA grant of \$7,500 for preschool resources.
- Ronald reported on Bridgerland Literacy. Their new website had 867 online visitors for the first month. The CDBG grant that funded the website has been completed. They have raised \$4,000 of the \$8,000 needed for the dyslexia program they want.
- Ronald informed the board that a former Logan resident and library patron who now lives in Maryland saw the Adopt a Book program on the Library Home Page and sent a \$100 donation.
- Ronald distributed updated copies of the Board Member Library Handbook. He informed the board that the next policy to be reviewed will be the Reference Policy.
- Ronald informed the board that the Logan High School Media center has received their LSTA grant.
- Ronald reported on the library's events for National Library Week in April, including Read Poster displays, radio contests, drawings for children, teenagers, and adults, and a Help Olivia count the books contest.
- Ronald reported on the status of the Trust Fund. He informed the board that the City has implemented online access to account information, which makes it possible to have more current information for the board meetings.
- Ronald reported on the status of the Library's Long Range Plan
- Ronald reviewed the Monthly Report for March 2003.
- Ronald demonstrated some changes to the Library Online Catalog. New features include content such as excerpts and reviews, slightly different wording for book lists, and a change in the MyBistro catalog.
