

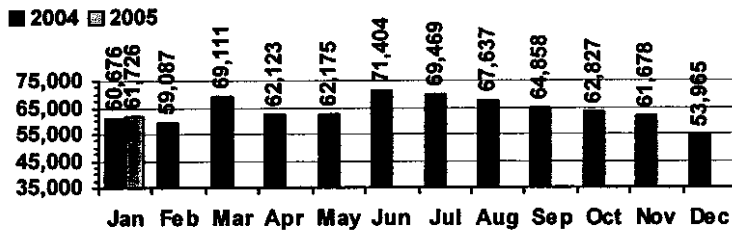

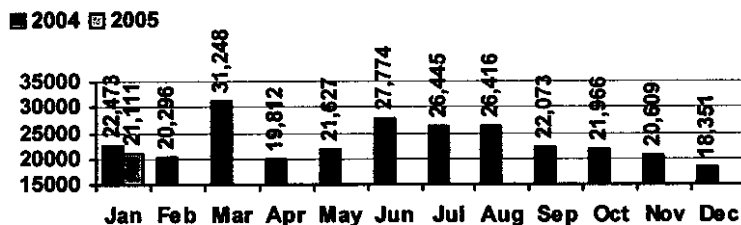

Patron Exit Count

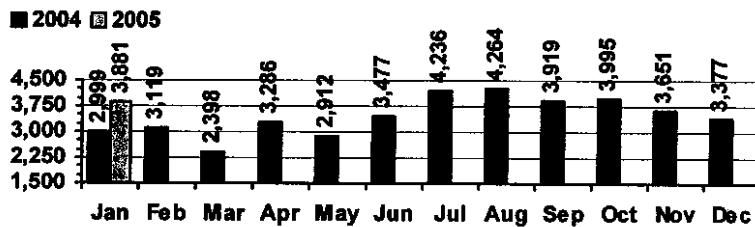

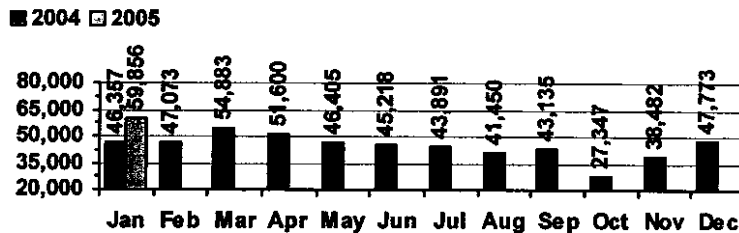

PROGRAMS / PROJECTS

1. **Storytime:**
 - Number of Sessions: 22

2. Ongoing Projects:

A. Electronic Notification - Ron and Janet

Removed 2800+ "bad" email addresses from patron accounts to facilitate implementing email notification on February 1, 2005.

B. Cataloging - Janet

JBIOGRAPHY PROJECT – Completed re-labeling of 1,159 books classed as JUVENILE BIOGRAPHY so that spine, labels, call numbers and computer entry were consistent and followed established call number patterns. Example: books labeled JB Washington with computer entry and call number of JUVENILE BIOGRAPHY Washington were changed to JBIOGRAPHY Washington.

ANIMAL RE-CLASS PROJECT – Completed a re-class project in subject area of animals to reflect changes in new edition of Dewey Decimal Classification. Evaluated 428 items – converted 408 and discarded 18. Example: Previous class number for bears was 599.74. Current class number for bears is 599.78.

MISCELLANEOUS RE-CLASS PROJECT – Completed small re-class projects in various subject areas. Evaluated 222 items – converted 177 and discarded 17.

COPY NUMBER REMOVAL PROJECT – Removed copy numbers from all non-fiction call numbers, assigned an item cat #1 to each and combined like items under one number record.
