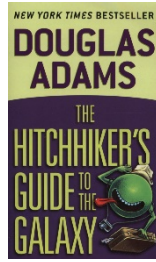


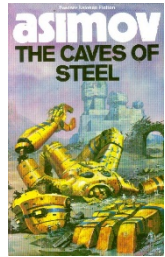

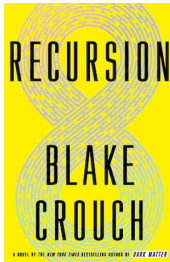
The hitchhiker's guide to the galaxy

Don't panic! Choose this interstellar adventure if you're looking for comedic charm and sarcasm in a life-and-death situation.



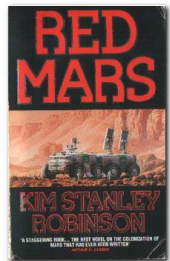
The caves of steel

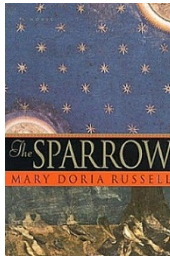
Recursion

In this puzzle box time-travel story, people suffer from a strange disease--False Memory Syndrome--giving them memories of a life they never lived.



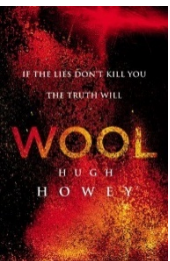
Red Mars

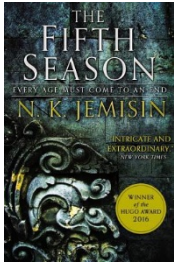

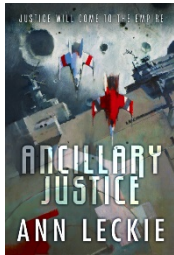

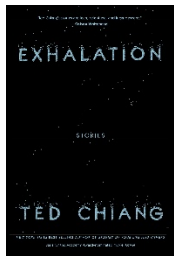
The fifth season

In a world plagued by cataclysmic tectonic activity, the only way to survive is to constantly prepare for the next fifth season.



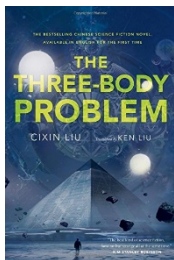
Ancillary justice

In 21st-century America, a teenaged computer hacker fights a computer virus that battles virtual reality technology and a deadly drug that turns humans into zombies.



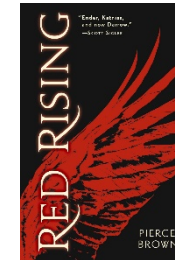
Ender's game

Ender Wiggin and fellow students at Battle School are tested and trained to determine whether they possess the abilities to remake the world--if the world survives war with an alien enemy.



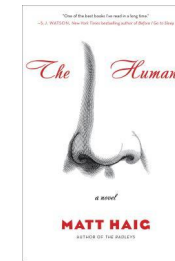
Out of the silent planet

16 year-old-Darrow works in the mines of Mars, a life of drudgery and subservience until his wife is executed by the government, and he's recruited by a rebel cell.



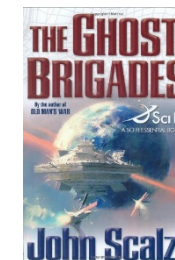
The humans
