## O R D I N A N C E .

AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PASSED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS ON THE 6th DAY OF JANUARY, 1920, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF APPOINTIVE OFFICERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH.

Be it ordained by the Board of City Commissioners of Logan City, Utah, as follows:

Section 1. That the ordinance passed by the City Commissioners on the 6th day of January, 1920, entitled "An ordinance fixing the salaries of appointive officers of Logan City, Utah" be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

That the annual salaries of appointive officers of Logan City, Utah, hereinafter named for the term of office to which each is or may be appointed, are hereby fixed as follows:-

ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FEES OF SEXTON, COST OF CEMETERY LOTS, AND CARE OF THE SAME, AND AMENDING SECTION 268, and 271 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF LOGAN CITY, 1912.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That Section 268 of the Revised Ordinances of Logan City, 1912, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 268. FEES FOR SERVICE OF SEXTON. The Sexton is hereby required to collect from those desiring his services, and pay into the City Treasury, the following fees:

- For digging a grave four feet six inches in length and four feet six inches deep, . . . . . \$ 3.00
- For all graves over four feet six inches in length, . . . . . 5.25
- For disintering bodies from a grave four feet or four feet six inches in length, . . . . . 3.00
- For disinterring bodies from a grave over four feet six inches in length, . . . . . 5.25
- For recording each death or removal, . . . . . .25
- For clipping hedge per season, per rod, . . . . . .50
- For watering and cutting lot, per season, . . . . . 3.00
- Vaults, . . . . . \$12.00 to 25.00

Section 11.- That Section 271 of the Revised ordinances of Logan City, 1912, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

Section 271. - FENCES. It shall be unlawful for any person to erect upon any lot in the cemetery of Logan City, any fence or ~~hedge~~ more than two feet in height, and no fence shall be constructed without permission of the Board of Commissioners.

Section 111. That Section 274 of the revised ordinances of Logan City, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

Section 274. SALE OF ~~CEMETERY~~ <sup>Perpetual Care.</sup> LOTS. Any person desiring to purchase vacant cemetery lots in Logan City, upon the condition that Logan City shall exercise perpetual care of the same, may do so upon payment to Logan City of the sum of \$85.00 for full lot, one rod square, which said sum shall be in payment for the said lot, for the planting of the same to grass, commonly called lawn, and in payment of all future water rates, watering and otherwise caring for said lot ~~together with shrubs and trees planted thereon by the owner;~~ provided that in the event any person now holding a title from Logan City to any cemetery lot desires to have the same planted to lawn and perpetually cared for by Logan City, and all future water rates paid, he may do so by payment to Logan City of the sum of \$75.00; provided, further, that if any person now holding title to any cemetery lot, the same having already been planted to lawn desires Logan City to perpetually care for same with all future water rates paid, he may do so by payment to Logan City of the sum of \$65.00; provided further that any person desiring to purchase a single grave lot, and have Logan City exercise perpetual care of the same, may do so upon payment to Logan City of the sum of <sup>15.00</sup> ~~20.00~~, said lot to be situated in such portion or part of the cemetery set apart by the City for said character of lots, ~~provided that monuments, or stones, upon such part of said cemetery so set apart, shall be restricted to the erection of a "Marker" made of stone, and set so that the top of the same shall not be to exceed two inches above the top or surface of the lawn. That the price of lots one rod square, without care, shall be 10.00~~



Section IV. That the ordinance passed by the Board of City Commissioners March 6th, 1916, known as 268-A, is hereby repealed.

Section V. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AND ESTABLISHING THE FIRE LIMITS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, AND AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PASSED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, ON THE 5TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1916, RELATING TO THE SAME SUBJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, as FOLLOWS:-

Section I. That Section one of an ordinance passed by the City Commissioners of Logan City, Utah, on the 5th day of October, 1916, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

Section I. That the following territory is hereby designated and established as the fire limits of Logan City, Utah, to-wit:-

All of blocks 2, 3, 14, 15, 18, 19, and the east half of Block 30, and the West half of Block 31, Plat "A" Logan City Survey, and the West half of Block 4, and the East half of Block 5, Plat "D" Logan City Survey.

Section II. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances of Logan City, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section III. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.

ORDINANCE .

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DRIVING OR WALKING ON THE PARKED PORTION OF STREETS AND SIDEWALKS IN LOGAN CITY, AND REPEALING AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SAME SUBJECT PASSED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, THE 16TH DAY OF APRIL, 1915.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to drive loose cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine, or any vehicle, or to unnecessarily walk upon the parked portion of any paved street or sidewalk of Logan City, Utah.

Section 2. That the ordinance passed by the Board of City Commissioners relating to the same subject matter, April 16th, 1915, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a public offense, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$50.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE KEEPING OF BEET PULP WITHIN CERTAIN LIMITS OF LOGAN CITY,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, as FOLLOWS:-

Section I. That it shall be unlawful for any person to keep, store or feed "beet pulp" within the following described district of said Logan City, Utah: all of that territory lying and being between third South and Third North Street, and Third West Street and Third East Street of said City.

Section II. That any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$50.00, or by imprisonment in the City jail not to exceed thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section III. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.
