AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SEWER AND SEWER CONNECTIONS, AMENDING SECTION 175 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF LOGAN CITY 1912.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Board of City Commissioners of Logan City, Utah, as follows:

SECTION 1 - That section 175 of the Revised Ordinances of Logan City, 1912, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

175. Privy, Vaults and Cesspools, to be filled and properly connected with sewer system in Sewer Districts. It shall be unlawful for any owner, agent or occupant of property abutting the sewer system embraced within the limits of any sewer district of Logan City, to refuse, fail, or neglect, for a period of twenty days after notice from the Board of Health of this City, to discontinue the use of, disinfect and fill up all privy vaults and cesspools on such property, or neglect or refuse for such period after such notice to remove the seat or seats from all outside closets on such property, or to neglect or refuse for such period such notice to make proper connection with the sewer system abutting such property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Unlawful to Permit Roller Skating on Sunday or After Midnight. It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct or maintain any public Roller Skating Rink, or Skating Rink, in any public hall or enclosure where an admission fee is charged upon any Sunday, or between the hours of 12:00 o'clock Midnight of any day and 6:00 o'clock A. M. of the following day, without the special authority first had and obtained from the Board of City Commissioners.

Section 2. Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not more than \$299.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail not more than three months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby deemed to exist and it is hereby Ordered that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication.


