ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 850, OF REVISED ORDINANCES
OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, 1927.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH,
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sections Amended, That Section 850 of Revised Ordinances of Logan City, 1927, be, and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

850. Supervisor, City Electrician, or Superintendent of Water Works May Order Removal of. The parking supervisor of the City Electrician, or the Superintendent of water works are hereby given authority to order the removal of any shade, or other tree, stump, shrub or vine, or any part of such tree, standing or growing on any street or sidewalk parking in Logan City, upon the ground that the same is deceased, dead, unsightly, undesirable, injurious or a nuisance upon the grounds that such tree interferes with, or may hereafter interfere with electric light, or telephone wires or poles in any street, alley, or sidewalk parking in this City; or upon the grounds that such a tree or trees, or the roots thereof interfere with or damage the sidewalk, curb and gutter or other street pavement, water mains, fire hydrants, sewer mains, pipes, or any sewer connections. In case said parking supervisor, or superintendent of water works shall order the removal of any such tree, stump, shrub, or vine, the same shall be removed by the owner thereof, at his own expense, within three weeks from the date of the service of a notice upon him to remove the same, and upon his failure to do so, they may be removed by the parking supervisor or superintendent of water works, at the expense of such owner, or abutting owner, All such expenses so incurred may be collected in

the name of the City against such owner, as in other actions. Such tree stump, etc. shall be removed not more than one foot above the ground and stump remaining must be properly salted or otherwise treated to kill all growth of the roots.

All trees growing or standing on any street, alley, or sidewalk parking are hereby declared to be under the control and jurisdiction of Logan City, and where any such tree or trees are out of the proper and established alignment, or when any such tree, or trees are decayed, dead or unsightly, or are injurious to or breaking up the paved portion of such sidewalk, or where such tree or trees interfere with or form an obstruction to any telephone or electric light line, wire, or pole, water main, fire hydrant, sewer main, or sewer connection, such tree or trees or any portion thereof, may be removed upon the written order of the street supervisor, City electrician, or superintendent of water works as hereinabove provided. A failure to remove such tree within three weeks after written notice served upon such owner or abutting owner, shall be deemed a misdemeanor and a violation of this ordinance.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby deemed to exist and it is hereby ordered that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication.

AN ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING WHOLESALE PEDDLERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in or pursue the business, vocation or calling of a wholesale Peddler in Logan City, Utah, without first obtaining a license so to do.

A wholesale peddler, for the purpose of this paragraph, shall be defined as any person, either principal or agent, and all firms, corporations, partnerships, or any other joint or singular enterprise engaged in by a person or persons, who travels from place to place or has a stand at any place in Logan City, and who peddles; sells or offers for sale any vegetables, grain, produce, butter, oleomargine, salad dressing, potatoe chips, meats or meat products, fish or fish products, bakery products, eggs, cheese, berries, fruits, nuts, melons, grapes, ice cream, or other food or food products, to retail dealers for the purpose of re-sale.

This section shall not apply to any grower or producer of any articles or ranch products specified herein, who peddles only produce owned, produced and grown by him, and who shall be entitled to a license without the payment of said fee, provided, however, such grower or producer shall first file with the City Recorder an affidavit setting forth his name and address, the amount and variety of produce he proposes to sell, the place where said produce is grown or produced and that said produce as he will sell will be only such as is actually grown and produced by him and upon payment of \$1.00 as a registration fee.

Section 2. The license fee for engaging in the business of a wholesale peddler shall be \$100.00 per year, or any part thereof.

Section 3. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$299.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not longer than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby deemed to exist and it is hereby Ordered that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication.
