

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PRODUCTION, TRANSPORTATION, PROCESSING, HANDLING, SAMPLING, EXAMINATION, GRADING, LABELING, REGRADING, AND SALE OF MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS; THE INSPECTION OF DAIRY HERDS, DAIRIES, AND MILK PLANTS; THE ISSUING AND REVOCATION OF PERMITS TO MILK PRODUCERS AND DISTRIBUTORS; THE PLACARDING OF RESTUARANTS AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS SERVING MILK OR MILK PRODUCTS; AND, THE FIXING OF PENALTIES AND REPEALING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF LOGAN CITY 1927 CONCERNING THE ABOVE MATTERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The production, transportation, processing, handling, sampling, examination, grading, labeling, re-grading, and sale of all milk and milk products sold for ultimate consumption within the City of Logan, or its police jurisdiction, the inspection of dairy herds, dairies, and milk plants, the issuing and revocation of permits to milk producers and distributors, the placarding of restaurants and other establishments serving milk or milk products, shall conform with the regulations which the Board of Health of Logan City may adopt under the authority hereby conferred. All rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Health shall be filed in the office of the City Auditor.

SECTION 2: From and after the six months from the date on which this ordinance takes effect no milk products shall be sold to the final consumer, restaurant, soda fountain, grocery store or similar establishment except A grade milk or A, B, and C grades of milk pasturized. Provided, that when any milk distributor fails to qualify for one of the above grades the Health Officer is authorized to revoke his permit, or in lieu thereof to degrade his product and permit its sale during a temporary period not exceeding 30 days or in emergencies such longer period as he may deem necessary.

SECTION 3: PENALTY. Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4: Sections 367 and 387 inclusive and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed; and this ordinance shall take effect six months after its adoption and publication.
