

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 598 OF THE ORDINANCES OF LOGAN CITY 1927, FIXING THE AGE AT WHICH MINORS MAY BE PERMITTED IN POOL HALLS AND PROHIBITING PERSONS UNDER TWENTY ONE YEARS OF AGE FROM ENTERING BEER HALLS OR ANY PLACE WHERE BEER IS SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE ON THE PREMISES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 598 of the Revised Ordinances of Logan City, 1927 be amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the owner, keeper, manager, licensee of, or employee in, any public billiard hall, or pool hall in Logan City, to permit or allow any person under the age of eighteen years to visit, frequent or remain in such billiard or pool hall, It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen years to visit, frequent or remain in any billiard or pool hall in Logan City.

It shall be unlawful for the owner, keeper, manager or licensee of or employee in, any beer hall, pool hall or other place where beer is sold or offered for sale for consumption on the premises to permit or allow any person under the age of 21 years to visit or frequent or remain in such beer hall, pool hall or other place where beer is sold or offered for sale for consumption on the premises. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to visit, frequent or remain in any beer hall, pool hall or other place where beer is sold or offered for sale for consumption on the premises.

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 77, OF REVISED ORDINANCE OF LOGAN CITY, 1927.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. Sections Amended. That section 77 of Revised Ordinances of Logan City, 1927, as amended by Ordinance passed the 28th day of September, 1929, and February 21st, 1939 be amended and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

77. Inner Fire and Business District. All that portion of Logan City abutting on Main Street from Sixth South, North to City limits, and on Second South Street from one-half block West to one-half block East of Main Street, and on First South Street from First West Street to one-half block East of Main Street, and on Center Street from First East Street to First West Street, and on First North Street from First East Street to First West Street, on First West Street from First South Street to First North Street, shall be included in and known as the Inner Fire and Business District.

Sec. 2. An emergency is hereby deemed to exist and it is hereby ordered that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication.

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND REGULATING USE OF PUBLIC STREETS IN THE CITY OF LOGAN; DEFINING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING METER ZONES; REGULATING AND CONTROLLING AND PROVIDING FOR INSPECTION OF THE PARKING OF VEHICLES THEREIN BY THE USE OF PARKING METERS; PRESCRIBING LIMITS OF TIME FOR PARKING IN PARKING METER ZONES; PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, STATE OF UTAH:

SECTION 1. Definitions.

(a) For the purpose of this ordinance the words "Parking Meter Zones," shall mean portions of streets described and established by the City Commissioners as Zones within which the parking of vehicles shall be controlled, regulated, and inspected with the aid of timing devices or meters, hereinafter referred to as parking meters or meters.

(b) The definition of any term used in this ordinance not otherwise herein defined shall be the same as such, as defined and described in the Vehicle Code of the State of Utah and amendments thereto, and ordinances of the City of Logan.

SECTION 2. PARKING METER ZONES ESTABLISHED. The following portions of streets in the City of Logan are hereby established as Parking Meter Zones;

Main Street: From First South to Third North

Center Street: From Main Street to First West and from Main Street to one-half block east.

First North Street: From Main Street to First West Street and from Main Street to one-block east.
