ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT FOR THE YEAR 1947.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH.

Section 1. That the following sums of money or as much thereof as may be necessary be and the same are hereby appropriated for the support of the various departments indicated for the year 1947:

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND PROHIBITING THE SALE OF UNCOOKED MEAT OR FISH ON SUNDAY AND LEGAL HOLIDAYS AND HOURS ON OTHER DAYS

SECTION 1. Unlawful to sell meats, etc on Sunday, etc.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership or corporation to engage in, carry on, or conduct the business of selling or dispensing uncooked or uncured meat, poultry or fish on Sunday or any legal holiday or any other day except between the hours of eight A. M. and Six P. M. provided that on Saturday or the day preceeding any legal holiday, it shall be unlawful to engage in, carry on or conduct said business after 6:30 P. M.

SECTION 2. Penalty. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof the defendant may be punished in the sum of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not to exceed thirty (30) days or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby deemed to exist and it is hereby ordered that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 95-A AND 95-B, AS PASSED AND ADOPTED
SEPTEMBER 4, 1936, TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

95-A Curb Pumps. Unlawful to maintain.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate or maintain any gasoline curb pump, on any curb or sidewalk parking in Logan City.

95-B Curb Pumps. Removal, Penalty.

It shall be the duty of every person, firm or corporation now maintaining a gasoline curb pump, or pumps, on any curb or sidewalk parking of Logan City, to cause the same to be removed before October 1, 1947.

Penalty. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$50.00 or imprisonment in City Jail not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Each additional day said pumps are so maintained in violation of this ordinance, after October 1, 1947, shall constitute and be deemed a separate offense.
