#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Agricultural College of Utah, has made application to the Board of City Commissioners of Logan City, for permission to construct and lay a pipe and connect the same with the City reservoir for the purpose of securing an adequate water supply for said college and its various departments, and in order to provide adequate fire protection, the said construction to be at the expense of said college, Now therefore,

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS William B. Preston, Mayor of Logan City, Cache County, Utah territory, attempted on February 16th, 1872, to convey by townsite deed, to Jens Nielsen, the property hereinafter described together with other lands pursuant to the Act of Congress entitled, "An Act for the relief of the inhabitants of Cities and Towns upon the public lands," approved March 2nd, 1867, and the Acts of the Legislature of the territory of Utah which said Acts of the said Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Utah were passed and approved to carry out and make effective the provisions of the said Act of Congress relative to public lands, And whereas the said Mayor in the said deed of conveyance failed to properly convey the said land on account of an erroneous description and that the said Pauline Gabrielsen and her predecessors in interest have been in continuous, notorious, hostile and undisputed possession of the said lands since the said 16th day of February, 1872. Now therefore to more effectually carry out the terms and provisions of the trust imposed by the said Act of Congress and the said Acts of the legislature of the territory of Utah, it is hereby resolved by the Board of City Commissioners of Logan City, Cache County, Utah, as successor in trust of William B. Preston, Mayor of Logan City, Cache County, Utah, for the land described as follows:

Beginning at the north-west corner of block seventeen (17) Plat "D" Logan City Survey, and running thence east eight (8) rods more or less to the petition fence thence south nineteen (19) rods, thence west eight (8) rods more less to street line, thence north nineteen (19) rods to the place of beginning with all improvements thereon, and all water right belonging to the above described tract of land.

And the said Mayor of Logan City is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the said deed of conveyance, Passed this 11th day of September, 1919. A.D.
