

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH,

THAT, Whereas, there is an immediate and pressing need of raising funds to defray current expenses, and for general corporate purposes,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Logan City for the purpose of defraying current expenses and for general corporation purposes, borrow the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars and for that purpose as evidence of such indebtedness, issue One (1) note therefore, for the sum of \$8,000.00, payable on or before January 15th, 1924, with interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum, payable at maturity, and Mayor John A. Crockett of said City is hereby authorized and empowered to sign the said note on behalf of said City and the City Recorder is authorized and empowered to attest the same, under the seal of the said City.

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Commissioners of Logan City, Cache County, Utah, as follows:

1. That it being the sense of the City Commissioners that City Employees shall not be allowed to allow any obligations owing from said employees to the City, to remain unpaid for a longer period than sixty (60) days after the same shall have been incurred, except by special arrangement with the City Commissioners.

2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to deduct from the salaries of any employees, any sum or sums due and unpaid to said City of Logan, or any of its departments thereof, where said sums shall remain unpaid for a longer period than sixty (60) days after the same shall have been incurred.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that permission be only granted to extend the time of payment beyond this period where arrangements are made specially with the City Commission before the obligations are incurred, and said arrangements to be a minute entry or other written evidence of the extension of time beyond said period, which said minute entry or other written evidence shall be filed with the City Auditor previous to the incurring of said obligation.

R E S O L U T I O N.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN CITY, UTAH,

THAT WHEREAS, at a special election held in Logan, City, Utah, on May 15, A. D. 1923, there was submitted to the qualified electors of said City who had paid a property tax in the year proceeding said election the question of incurring a bonded indebtedness in the sum of \$300,000.00 for the purpose of constructing and installing an additional lighting system and works for the purpose of supplying said City and the inhabitants thereof with artificial light, and,

WHEREAS, a majority of the qualified electors of said City, voting at said election, voted in favor of said proposition submitted as aforesaid, which result was duly ascertained and declared by the Board of Commissioners of said City, sitting as a Board of Canvassers on Monday, May 21st, 1923, and,

WHEREAS, by ordinance of said City, duly and regularly passed, made and entered on the 11th day of September, A. D. 1923, said City duly provided for the issuance of \$200,000 of the bonds so authorized, which bonds bear date of September 1st 1923, denomination \$1,000 each, numbered from 1 to 200 both inclusive, and,

WHEREAS, by resolution heretofore passed, on the 2nd day of November, A. D. 1923, said City duly sold and delivered to Palmer Bond & Mortgage Company, a corporation, of the State of Utah, One Hundred Thousand Dollars of said bonds so issued, said bonds being numbered from 1 to 100, and

WHEREAS, by resolution heretofore passed on the 15th day of November, A. D. 1923, said City duly sold and delivered an additional One Hundred Thousand Dollars of said bonds so authorized to said Palmer Bond and Mortgage Company, said bonds being numbered from 101 to 200 both inclusive.

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient and necessary at this time to sell the remaining \$100,000 of the bonds, out of the total authorized issue of \$300,000 bonds so voted as aforesaid, and

WHEREAS, said Palmer Bond & Mortgage Company, has offered to purchase said remaining \$100,000 of said bonds so authorized, which said offer of purchase is in words and figures as follows to-wit:

Logan City, Utah.

Gentlemen:

For \$100,000 5% Light Bonds of Logan City, Utah, to be dated February 1, 1924, due twenty years from date of issue, to be accompanied by the approving opinion of Mr. John C. Thomson, to be payable both principal and semi-annual interest in New York City, we offer you \$1015.00 and accrued interest for each \$1,000 bond delivered to us.

It is understood and agreed that the City will furnish without cost to us the approving opinion of John C. Thomson, and the printed bonds. The total cost for such opinion and bonds not to exceed \$260.00,

To maintain City Hall.	1 mill on the dollar.
